(1) Orsi Vigneto San Vito, Sui Lieviti Pignoletto Frizzante Brut, Colli Bolognesi 2014 95

£22 (2017) Noble Fine Liquor, Tutto Wines Reverting to the rifermentato technique used by his grandfather, Federico Orsi produces this wine with a second fermentation in bottle. Without disgorgement, the indigenous-yeast lees provide protection from oxidation. At the time of tasting, the wine had spent four years on the lees, giving it sweet-pastry aromas and a dry, creamy palate with plush peachy fruits and yeasty spiciness. Organic. ② Tenuta Santacroce, Metodo Famigliare Sur Lie Pignoletto Frizzante Brut, Colli Bolognesi NV 92

This is an estate owned by the Chiarli
family and it has 30ha of vines, about half
of which are Grechetto Gentile. Made with
a second fermentation in bottle and no
disgorgement, this wine has aromas of
cinnamon and savoury pastry, melding
with orange skin and marmalade piquancy
for complexity on the palate. Shows good
concentration. SE Drink 2020-2023 Aic 12%

Cevico, Romandiola Pignoletto Frizzante Brut, Colli d'Imola 2018 91

£9.95-£11.95 Exel, Haligarten Wines,
The Drink Shop, Vin Cognito
Romandiola is the ancient name for
Romagna. From Terre Cevico, a large,
well-established cooperative, the grapes
are grown on the hillsides above Imola and
picked by hand. Herbal notes and hawthorn
blossom on the nose, expressive and
elegant palate with yellow-citrus flavours, a
hint of lychee and a rounded finish. Tasted

③ Balli Vini, L'Ancestrale Pignoletto Spumante Brut Nature, Colli Bolognesi 2017 89

This 10-month lees-aged cuvée from
Alessio Balestri shows appealing
yeastiness and development. A steelysavoury nose with complex hints of
nuttiness leads to a rich palate with
honeyed breadth. Baked apples and
raisins are well balanced against its
steely-dry frame, supple mousse and long
finish. SE Drink 2020-2022 Alc 13%

◆ Castelvetro, Pignoletto Extra Dry NV 89 £11.95-£17.99 Bonafide Wines, Enotria&Coe,

Simply Wines Direct, The Wine Centre
The vineyards for this extra-dry wine have
long been owned by the Chiarli family.
They are located in the hills near the
village of Castelvetro in Modena, and the
wine is made in the Cleto Chiarli cellars
there. It has a toasty, flinty note to the
nose and is well balanced on the palate,
with persistent bubbles and refreshing
flavours of grapefruit and pear. CC

II Monticino, Frizzante del Monticino Pignoletto Brut, Colli Bolognesi NV 89

From a 2.5ha Morandi family vineyard at 200m-250m in the hills close to Bologna. Made in the Charmat-Martinotti method, with about 40 days on lees. The nose has green apple, pear, peach, even a hint of tropical melon, reflected on the palate with spiky-fresh yet soft lemon-sorbet frothiness. SE Drink 2020-2021 Alc 12%

Villa Claidini, Pignoletto Millesimato Brut 2018 89

£14.99-£16.30 Alexander Hadleigh, Exel, Hangingditch, Harrogate Fine Wine Co, Liberty Wines. The Wine Reserve



Another from Chiarli vineyards, made by Franco De Biasio. Lively apple and citrus aromas are followed by a full palate with light almondy notes, then a refreshing citrussy finish of grapefruit and hints of herbs. CC Drink 2020-2022 Aic 12%

Riunite, Tesco Finest Pignoletto Spumante Brut 2018 88

Made in partnership with one of Emilia Romagna's largest cooperatives, which boasts 1,700 growers and specialises in both red and white sparkling wines. It has an attractive white-floral nose, followed by refreshing apple and pear notes on the palate. The soft bubbles leave a bright and clean finish. CC Drink 2020-2022 Aic 11.5%

Sainsbury's, Taste the Difference Pignoletto Spumante Brut NV 88

Grapes undergo cold maceration for 10 hours, then soft pressing. The must ferments at low temperatures and the Charmat-Martinotti method is used, with about 30 days on the lees. A light, floral nose leads to red-apple flavours on the palate, a pleasant hint of bitterness and a lively finale. CC Drink 2020-2022 Aic 11%

Valiona, Ammestesso Pignoletto, Colli Bolognesi Classico Superiore 2014 95

N/A UK www.fattorievallona.it Grechetto Gentile grown at about 300m, matured in cement tanks for three years on lees with stirring. A complex wine that shows aromas of honey, cinnamon and steeliness. Creamy in texture, fresh, rich, concentrated and silky smooth, with flavours of honeyed quince and sweet spices. Well balanced and poised. SE Drink 2020-2023 Aic 14%

Grechetto Gentile is hand-harvested then fermented in stainless steel to preserve the grape's natural aromatics. Shows white-floral aromas, fresh quince and apple, along with more concentrated notes of baked apples and pears. The palate is smooth, fresh and wholesome, with good flavour density and a long finish. SE Drink 2020-2022 Aic 12.5%

Aldrovandi, Alto Vanto Bianco, Colli Bolognesi Classico Superiore 2017 89

Some of the fruit for this wine comes from Pignoletto vines dating back to 1938, on sommelier Federico Aldrovandi's single hectare in Monteveglio. Fermented in French oak, one-third of which is new. Aromas of honeyed buttercream and lemon toast also show on the round palate. Honeycomb richness, smooth texture and creamy concentration. SE Drink 2020-2022 Aic 13.5%
